## Student Services Return Protocol for 2022-2023

**Board Action August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021, December 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021, June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022, and December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022**

**Reviewed on September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021, and January 10<sup>th</sup> 2022**

**All Plans on this Document are Subject to Change with Administration Action**

**Pre-Screening for Students:** We encourage parents to screen their children at home before school starts. Please keep your children home if sick. Students with a temperature of 100 or higher will need to be isolated and parents will be expected to pick them up from school.

**Vaccination:** We encourage families to vaccinate students based on current CDC guidance but will not be requiring Covid-19 vaccinations.  
Current guidance provides for all student 12 years and older to receive a vaccination.

**Transportation:** Social Distancing will be hard to achieve when riding the school bus. We offer bus routes as an option for parents; it is up to every family whether you want your children to ride or not.

**Pick-Up/Drop-Off of Students:** We would encourage parents stay in their vehicle during pick-up and drop-off when possible.

**Masks:** At this time masks are optional and not a requirement. The school district at some point this year may require masks on district property and in school vehicles. Masks should cover nose and mouth.

**Hand Washing/Hand Sanitizing:** Hand Sanitizer will be available in all classrooms. Bathroom breaks will be scheduled in such a way as to discourage a lack of social distancing and encourage frequent handwashing. The school district encourages both handwashing and respiratory etiquette.

**Surface Cleaning:** Surfaces will be cleaned with FDEA approved cleaners.

**Restrooms:** We will use a privacy wall in front of the restroom entrances, so there will be no reason to open and close the door.

**Dressing for Physical Education:** We will socially distance and stagger times for dressing in locker rooms for PE.

**Visitors to School:** To limit outside exposure, we will limit access to persons who are not school employees or students. Please make an appointment when you would like to visit.

**Response to Students who become COVID symptomatic during the day:** The Castlewood School District will follow guidance from the South Dakota Department of Health. If a student or staff member becomes sick with COVID-19 symptoms during the school day, the student/staff member will be sent home.

**Positive Cases:** COVID Positive test will result in a 5-day isolation requirement for both students and staff. On day 6, students and staff may return to school if asymptomatic and masks recommended. If a student or staff member becomes sick at school, they will be sent home as soon as possible.
