

# John and Delice Gleysteen Memorial Scholarship

**\$1,000**

**The children of John and Delice Gleysteen: Jane Gleysteen Bobzin (Class of 1962), Arlys Gleysteen Sikorski (Class of 1966) and Ron Gleysteen (Class of 1968) have established a scholarship fund for a graduating Castlewood High School student who has actively shown an interest in music or other Fine Arts (art, drama, theater, or dance).**

**John and Delice farmed west of Castlewood and their children attended school in Castlewood. John and Delice appreciated the fine arts and always encouraged their children to participate in the arts, particularly music. To encourage students to participate in music and fine arts, their children thought it only appropriate to honor their parents with this scholarship.**

## **ELIGIBILITY**

Applicant must:

- Be a graduating senior Castlewood High School.
- All degrees will be considered but preference will be given to a student pursuing a degree in Music, Music Education or other fine Arts (art, drama, theater, dance or music performance).
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Submit a short essay (400 word maximum) describing how you have benefited from your participation in music and fine arts activities.

## **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

Type or print all requested information. Complete the scholarship application in full. If any information is incomplete, the application will be rejected.

- Complete application.
- Prepare a short essay (400 word maximum) describing how you have benefited from your participation in music and fine arts activities. The essay portion of the application is one of the most important sections of the application; please make sure to use spell-check and grammar-check before submitting your essay.
- Include a copy of your most recent grade transcript.
- Submit application and all attachments to the Castlewood School Administrative office prior to March 31.

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- One scholarship, in the amount of \$1000 will be awarded on a one time basis and will not be renewable. In the event there are no qualified applicants as outlined in the scholarship criteria above, the scholarship will not be awarded.
- Award will be issued payable to educational institution at the beginning of second semester of academic year.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered. Refer to the checklist on the application form to ensure that all components of the application have been fulfilled.
- Award recipient will be determined by the Castlewood Education Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee, based on submitted application and required material.

10% - GPA – Academics

50% - Fine Arts Activities

10% - Community Activities

10% - School Activities

20% - Fine Arts Essay
